Phrasal Verb	Meaning	Example
Get on	1. To get on a bus, get inside a bus 2. To have a good relationship with so	1. We couldn't get on because there were lots of people on the bus 2. I don't get on very well with Lucy?
Wake up	To stop sleeping	When did you wake up?
Find out	Discover	What did you find out?
Think over	Think about something for a time, consider	I need to think over.
Give up	Stop trying	Don't give up! Never give up!
Hang on	Wait for a short time.	Hang on a minute.
Dress up	Wear nice and beautiful clothes	I want to dress up tomorrow.
Take off	1. When the plane starts moving and flies up. 2. To stop wearing clothes	1. I was afraid of flying but when the plane took off I stopped being nervous. 2. I want to take of this pullover it's so uncomfortable.
Come back	Return	When are you coming back?
Calm down	Relax	Please calm down.
Fall down	Fall to the ground	Careful! You can fall down that way.
Grow up	Become an adult	Everyone grows up except Peter Pan.
Pass away	Die	She passed away last month.
